# **STAFF REPORT**

#### **SUBJECT:**

Annual Adjustment of the Regional Transportation Impact Fee (RTIF)

# **RECOMMENDED ACTION:**

Recommend SJCOG Board Approve Annual Administrative Fee Adjustment Calculation

#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### SUMMARY:

Based on Section 3.2 from the RTIF Operating Agreement, the region-wide RTIF fee schedule is annually adjusted by each Participating Agency at the beginning of each fiscal year (July 1). The approved annual adjustment methodology is a rolling three-year average of the Engineering News Record California Construction Cost Index (CCCI). Based on this methodology, an adjustment of the fees of +2.75% is indicated. Attachment "A" provides the calculation details.

The Mitigation Fee Act (AB 1600) requires development fee programs to undergo a review and update every five years to ensure the nexus analysis and fee schedule reflect current growth assumptions, projects costs, and transportation system impacts. The 2017 RTIF AB 1600 Update was approved by the SJCOG Board in April 2017. The "Other" category was reevaluated, based off local data or ITE trip generation rates more reflective of the projects that typically fall in this category. These are generally development projects that have minimal or no building area and yet would generate impacts to the transportation network, such as mining or recreational facilities. The current RTIF fee for the "Other" category was reduced to not exceed the maximum justified fee in the 2017 RTIF AB 1600 Update. Table 1, below, illustrates the new fee resulting from the annual administrative adjustment methodology discussed above and reevaluation of the "Other" category from the RTIF AB 1600 Update.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Recommend approval of the new RTIF fee schedule resulting from the annual administrative adjustment to go into effect July 1, 2017.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT:**

The ongoing cost of administering the RTIF is anticipated in SJCOG's FY 17-18 Overall Work Program (OWP) and will not be affected by this action.

Development fees will be adjusted. There will be an increase in RTIF revenue of:

- \$88.63 for each single-family dwelling unit,
- \$53.18 for each multi-family dwelling unit,
- \$0.04 for each square foot of retail space,
- \$0.04 for each square foot of office space,
- \$0.03 for each square foot of commercial/industrial space,
- \$0.01 for each square foot of warehouse space,

The 2017 RTIF AB 1600 Update recalculated the RTIF rate for the "Other" or per trip category, reducing RTIF revenue by \$40.08 per trip for projects subject to this revised fee calculation.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

#### **Administrative Fee Adjustment**

The original RTIF Operating Agreement was fully executed by SJCOG and all member agencies in 2006; a revised agreement was approved by the SJCOG Board in April 2015 and was approved by resolution by the governing boards of each member jurisdiction as of October 2015. As part of the program's policy, the RTIF fee structure is to be administratively adjusted on an annual basis. Section 3.2 from the Operating Agreement states that the fee shall be adjusted by each Participating Agency on an annual basis at the beginning of each fiscal year (July 1) based on a three-year rolling average of the California Construction Cost Index (CCCI). The indices and adjustment calculation are detailed below. The historical CCCI table is included as Attachment A to the staff report. April CCCI statistics of the past four years determined the growth percentage per year. The yearly growth percentage is averaged to derive the fee percentage increase for fee adjustment.
