SUBJECT: Climate Adaptation Planning Grant Award

and Authorization for Executive Director to Execute all Caltrans Contracts and related

Amendments

RECOMMENDED ACTION: Approve Resolution R-20-03 Authorizing

the Executive Director or his/her Designee to Execute all Caltrans Transportation

Funding Contracts and Related Amendments

SUMMARY:

In Spring 2019, the California State Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announced awards for the FY 19-20 Climate Adaptation Planning Grant Program, funded by the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, SB 1. SJCOG was awarded \$200,000 to develop a Phase II implementation plan that will build on an ongoing Phase I planning study to assess climate vulnerability of the regional transportation system. While SJCOG staff already has Board authority to execute the funding agreement with Caltrans, SJCOG staff determined this may be a good opportunity to update the 2015 resolution which delegates this authority to the Executive Director.

SJCOG conducts transportation funding contracts and related amendments with Caltrans on a regular basis. These transactions are supported by the SJCOG approved Overall Work Program (OWP). This includes, but not limited to the following:

- Congestion Mitigation Air Quality;
- Project Planning, Programming, and Monitoring;
- Freeway Service Patrol;
- Transportation Planning Grants;
- Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account.

Previously through 2015 Resolution R-16-05, SJCOG Board delegated the authority to the SJCOG Executive Director or his/her designee, which may include the Deputy Executive Director or other designee, to execute all Caltrans transportation funding contracts and related amendments supported by the OWP. The attached Resolution R-20-03, updates the resolution with a current date of 2019.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve Resolution R-20-03 authorizing the Executive Director or his/her designee, which may include the Deputy Executive Director or other designee, to execute all Caltrans transportation funding contracts and related amendments. This resolution would be used for the above-referenced Caltrans Adaptation Grant and all future successful grants and funding from Caltrans.

FISCAL IMPACT:

There will be a new grant to the FY 2019/2020 SJCOG Overall Work Program (OWP), and reflected in a separate SJCOG staff item entitled OWP Amendment #1 (also on the Board's September agenda). The scope of work is funded through a FY 2019/2020 Caltrans Climate Adaptation Planning Grant (SB 1) and will not exceed \$200,000. A required local match of 11.5% is funded with LTF in the amount of \$25,912. The grant funds will expire on February 28, 2022.
