SUMMARY:

• Reallocate other funds to work elements reflecting actual year-to-date expenses

No revenue source or total expenditures have increased or decreased, only the distribution in work elements has been changed. The following summarizes the specific actions of the proposed amendment:

- Increase work element 602.01 Transportation Improvement Plan by \$22,000.00 of Local funds
- Increase work element 701.01 Technical Assistance by \$13,000 of Local Funds
- Increase work element 801.06 Valley MPO Coordination by \$9,000 of Local Funds
- Decrease work element 1001.02 LTF Planning funds by \$54,000
- Increase work element 1001.03 Community Involvement by \$10,000 of Local Funds

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed amendment is revenue and expenditure neutral and has no other fiscal impact.
